International Seminar September 1-2, 2015

Prior to the Education Symposium Switzerland and International School Leadership Symposium 2015 we offer an international seminar.

This year school leaders taking part in professional development programmes in a range of countries are specially invited to participate. However, the seminar is open for all and we encourage participants with different roles and responsibilities within the education system to participate. So far, we anticipate participants from Norway, Sweden, Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Spain and Australia.

The focus of the International Seminar is on exchange of knowledge and experiences across countries and discussion of challenges related to *Leadership for the 21st Century Learning* which recently was put on the agenda by the OECD.

According to the OECD, learning leadership is fundamental because it is about setting direction, taking responsibility for putting learning at the centre and keeping it there. This becomes increasingly complex in 21st century settings, calling for innovation and going beyond the heroics of individual leaders. Many need to be involved, bringing in diverse partners at different levels.

The International Seminar provides an excellent opportunity for international networking and includes a joint dinner at Guggital Hotel in the evening on the 1st of September as well as school visits in the morning on the 2nd of September.
